

Spanish Archivo

Spanish Archivo is a website that contains resources for the teaching and learning of the Spanish language and Hispanic cultures.

- Standards – The five Cs (Communication, Culture, Connections, Comparisons, and Communities) are addressed through **content standards** (what a student should know) and **performance standards** (what a student should be able to do).
 - Content standards – vocabulary, grammar, and culture
 - Performance standards – reading, listening, writing, and speaking
- Curricula – The content and performance standards are categorized into measurement categories and learner outcomes providing the **scope** (breadth and depth) of material to be learned at each level.
- Syllabi – The standards are presented in **sequence** (the order) in which the standards are to be learned. Each level contains its own syllabus with links to lessons. All lessons link to content, exercises and assessments.
- Exercises – The standards are practiced through online and traditional exercises. All content standards have online practice materials. Online exercises are also provided for the performance standards of reading and listening. Traditional exercises are presented to practice writing and speaking.
- Assessments – Diagnostic, formative and summative assessments provide feedback to students and teachers about readiness for learning, pace of learning, and mastery of learning.
